What to Expect:

- Contestants check in with hair and makeup already done. You may change into your evening gown attire in the dressing room
- Bring your photo (to enter the photogenic competition) in any size up to 8x10, in a photo frame for placement on the display table
- Line-up number is given at check in
- Contestants will first meet the audience in a walk around the stage, led by the reigning queen, then line up at the back of the stage for introductions
- In numerical order, contestants will introduce themselves with the following: Name, Age, School attending and Contestant number...you can be creative with this!
- Next, contestants have individual evening gown competition. The emcee will introduce contestants individually and read their application answers as contestants model
- Contestants are scored on poise, personality, facial and overall impression
- After competition is over, contestants may meet quickly with the judges in the judges room to gather feedback for improvement for next year.

Awards

Awards will be given in all categories for Prettiest Hair, Prettiest Eyes, Prettiest Smile, Best Fashion, Photogenic, and Miss Congeniality.

All contestants' pictures are placed on display for the public to vote on a People's Choice Award. Vote as many times as you want at only a \$1 per vote!

Princess Miss St. Tammany wins a trophy, crown, sash and official fair pin. Upon completion of her year reign, she will be presented with a \$300 cash scholarship from the St. Tammany Parish Fair Association.

Jr. Miss St. Tammany wins a trophy, crown, sash and official fair pin. Upon successful completion of her year reign, she will be presented with a \$500 cash scholarship from the St. Tammany Parish Fair Association.

Miss St. Tammany wins a trophy, crown, scepter, sash and official fair pin. She will represent St. Tammany Parish Fair at the annual Louisiana Association of Fairs and Festivals Convention held in February (entry fee, room and board paid by the St. Tammany Parish Fair Association). Upon completion of her year reign, she will be presented with a \$750 cash scholarship from the St. Tammany Parish Fair Association and a \$250 cash scholarship from the Donald L. Primes Memorial Scholarship Fund. She will receive scholarships totaling \$1000!

Queens will receive numerous invitations for various events throughout the state of Louisiana. Although these opportunities are optional, please remember that your reign only lasts for one year so make as many memories as you can (because it will quickly fly by)!

St. Tammany Parish Fair Pageant Contestant Rules and Regulations

- 1. Contestant must be a resident of or attend school in St. Tammany Parish. Contestant must be a naturally born female. Contestant must be single, never been married, never have had a child and not currently pregnant. Contestant may not be living in common law.
- 2. Contestant's age group is determined by her age on the day of the contest.
- 3. Please be on time for all events. The pageant will not be delayed due to tardiness of a contestant. Two points will be deducted from your total score each time.
- 4. Due to limited space, once pageant check-in is complete at 3:30 pm, only contestants are allowed in the dressing rooms. No males allowed in dressing rooms. Please help your contestant set up in dressing room and leave immediately.
- 5. Should a contestant decide not to compete or is deemed ineligible after the entry fee is paid, the fee will not be refunded.
- 6. Should any contestant or parent at any time display inappropriate or unsportsmanlike conduct towards another contestant, parent or any member of the St. Tammany Parish Fair Pageant Volunteers, they will be asked to leave the premises and will forfeit eligibility to compete. Unsportsmanlike conduct is not tolerated. This is a friendly competition and learning experience.
- 7. Contestants' photographs or basic information may be used by the fair in press releases for promoting their accomplishments in the pageant.
- 8. A contestant may not hold a binding or festival title at the time of the competition (meaning they can ONLY represent that particular title). If a contestant holds any non-binding or non-festival title, she agrees that her first obligation is to the St. Tammany Parish Fair. If it is discovered that a contestant holds another binding or festival title, she will forget her eligibility to compete; if a contestant has previously held a binding or festival title she must be in good standing with her past organization(s). If a contestant holds a title but is near the end of her reign, she may present a letter of release from her director allowing her to compete.
- 9. The judges are given the same information as the contestants and are encouraged to select the contestant who will make the best Queen. The judges are qualified, experienced and do not reside in St. Tammany Parish. The judges' decisions are final.
- 10. Those crowned queen will sign an official queen's behavior contract. Failure to abide by the queens' contract may result in forfeiture of title, crown and prizes.
- 11. Princess and Jr. Miss queen must commit to attending a minimum of 6 events during the course of their reign. Attendance at fair events is mandatory as you will reign over the fair.
