

St. Tammany Parish Fair 2023 Poster Contest Rules

- 1. Subject of poster shall be: St. Tammany Parish Fair Name, Location and Date of fair must be on poster:
 - i. St. Tammany Parish Fair
 - ii. 1304 N. Columbia St., Covington, LA
 - iii. October 4th 8th
- 2. Any public, private, parochial or homeschool school student may participate.
- 3. Posters will be judged in the following four categories:

Grades 1-3

Grades 4-6

Grades 7-9

Grades 10-12

- 4. Artwork must be on 14"x22" white poster paper. (1/2 sheet of standard poster paper).
- 5. All work must be vertical. Nothing horizontal will be judged.
- 6. All lettering must be free-hand. Do not use stencils.
- 7. Medium used shall be: Crayon, Watercolor, Acrylics, Felt-Tip Pen, or Oil. No cut-outs or Collages.
- 8. Information card (5"x7" index card) should be placed on the left top corner of the poster in such a way that it can be flipped over from front to back and include the following:

- 9. First, Second, and Third place winners in each category are eligible for state competition. First, Second and Third place posters will become property of St. Tammany Parish Fair. They will be submitted to the Louisiana Association of Fairs and Festivals state competition held in February 2024.
- 10. Posters will be judged and points awarded as follows:

Originality 34% Theme 25% Neatness 25% Spelling 15%

11. Poster Prizes:

Third Place \$25.00 Second Place \$50.00 First Place \$75.00

a. All posters are due:

-can drop poster off Monday, Oct 2nd or Tuesday Oct 3 at fairground office between hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm

-can mail poster to fair P.O. Box 2554, Covington 70434 no later than September 21st to give it time to get to post office then fairgrounds -posters will be set on display Wednesday, Oct 4th and judged that day
