Only one article may be entered by an exhibitor for each premium number (sets of items should be self-contained). Premium will be given to worthy exhibits only, regardless of entries. Judging will be done according to accepted standards.

Baked Goods: Bring only ¼ pie, cake, or cobbler (unless decorated). Must be on throw away heavy plate or cardboard.

Cookies & Candies: Bring ½ dozen in plastic bag.

IMPORTANT: NO cream pies or cheesecake will be accepted. Refrigeration is not available.

Sweepstakes Points: Premium - \$10.00 (*cannot be won two years in a row*)

Premiums: 1st - \$4.00 2nd - \$2.00 (1 Blue Ribbon = 1 point / 2 Red Ribbons = 1 point / 3 White Ribbons = 1 point)
