- 1. All exhibitor numbers will be assigned when dropping off items.
- 2. All Sr. Home Economics Exhibit items will be accepted on the Monday of Fair Week, from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. in the Sylvia Rivers Home Economics Building on the Covington Fairgrounds.
- 3. Only one article may be entered by an exhibitor for each premium number. Items must be made by the exhibitor. Only items listed on the form will be accepted.
- 4. Each item should be labeled with the name and phone number. This should be attached securely to the article.
- 5. All items will need to be brought to the Covington Fairgrounds if they would like to enter.
- 6. All items that meet the guidelines will be awarded a blue, red or white ribbon.
- 7. Reasonable care will be given to exhibits, but **the Fair Association will not be responsible for losses**. It is suggested that valuable items not be entered.
- 8. Articles will be displayed as space permits.
- 9. All items must be picked up on the <u>Monday after the Fair</u>, from 8:00 a.m. until Noon. We will not be responsible for any items left in the building after **Noon on Monday**.
